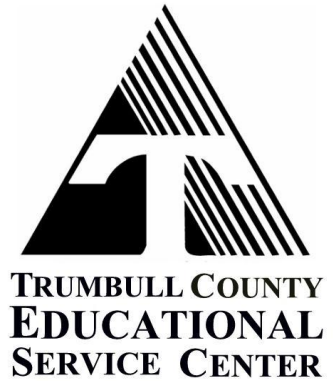


OH WOW!
