

## CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING TEXT DEPENDENT QUESTIONS

Typical text dependent questions ask students to perform one or more of the following tasks:

- Analyze paragraphs on a sentence by sentence basis and sentences on a word by word basis to determine the role played by individual paragraphs, sentences, phrases, or words.
- Investigate how meaning can be altered by changing key words and why an author may have chosen one word over another.
- Probe each argument in persuasive text, each idea in informational text, each key detail in literary text, and observe how these build to a whole.
- Examine how shifts in the direction of an argument or explanation are achieved and the impact of those shifts.
- Questions why authors choose to begin and end when they do.
- Note and assess patterns or writing and what they achieve.
- Consider what the text leaves uncertain or unstated.
