





This program is sponsored by Prevent Blindness Ohio and the Ohio Department of Health and helps families pay for eye exams and glasses for students who qualify.

Applications can be made through <u>Trumbull County Health Department</u> by calling <u>330-675-2590 push #3</u> for the nursing division.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant's family income is no more than 200% of Federal poverty guidelines.
- 2. Child is not enrolled in Medicaid or other Vision Insurance.
- 3. Child is 18 years of age or younger or has not graduated from High School.
- 4. Child is a U.S. citizen or resident alien.

<u>Application Process:</u>

- 1. When a family calls for information, the Medical Assistant/Secretary talks with the family and sends an application form and letters explaining the Sight for Students program.
- 2. The parent completes the highlighted portion of the application, signs, and dates and returns it to us in the self addressed envelope.
- 3. The application is then copied for our records and mailed to Prevent Blindness Ohio.
- 4. If applicant is eligible a voucher packet will be sent to us and we in turn will mail it to the family with a letter and form to return after seeing a physician so we can complete our records for Prevent Blindness Ohio.
